RE: Update: Pay Increases for Full-time Faculty and Staff

As noted in this [March 29 memo](#), funds to make the \$5,000 Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) pay increases permanent were included in the Governor's FY 2023 budget recommendations. These increases needed to be approved by the General Assembly as part of the FY 2023 state budget and receive final approval by the Governor before becoming permanent.

We are pleased to share that the General Assembly supported the Governor's recommendation to make these \$5,000 pay increases permanent when it approved the FY 2023 state budget earlier this week. While the state budget is pending final approval by the Governor, the University of Georgia will reflect these increases as a permanent part of base compensation for eligible faculty and staff in the FY 2023 budget it will submit to the Board of Regents for approval next month. We remain deeply grateful to the Governor and the General Assembly for continuing to recognize the talent, hard work and dedication of our faculty and staff.
